Parentpay

Please do consider logging onto Parentpay on-line to pay the annual £12 charge for school trips and activities. If parents choose not to pay this amount they will be charged separately for the trips including theatre trips in December. The Panto at Christmas will cost £10 for those who do not pay the **£12 before 30th September**. Learning lighthouse trips will be charged at approximately £3 depending on the activities. Please do consider this efficient way of paying in one go as it reduces administration costs to the school. Remember that if your child qualifies for free school meals or is a pupil premium child (eg. Children who have parents in the armed services or in care) there is no charge at all. All school meals and Dragon Club services must be paid for a week in advance. If you need advice about how to log on to Parentpay, please contact the school office.
